A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends.

At Harborlight Homes, we feel profoundly fortunate to have you in our corner, especially in times like these

We entered 2025 with strength and purpose, launching four impactful projects across three communities. These efforts include housing for young adults aging out of foster care, affordable homes for families, the revitalization of 60-year-old housing serving elders and families, and the boldest expansion yet of our resident services (made possible entirely through generous philanthropy – and we are not done yet!).

Our project pipeline continues to grow, and we are ready for what lies ahead. But we are also watching carefully as federal and state housing policies evolve. Of particular concern is the future of federal rental vouchers. A freeze on new vouchers - or even maintaining current funding levels without adjustment for rising costs - would make it nearly impossible to create housing for those with the greatest need or may strain the wrap-around resident services that are core to our model.

Similarly, we are concerned about critical funding sources like HOME, the National Housing Trust Fund, and Community Development Block Grants and their durability, just as the need for affordable housing has never been greater.

And yet, we press on. Asbury Commons in Hamilton, 45 affordable homes for individuals and families, has been awarded funding and is on track to break ground in early 2026. Several other developments are in various stages of funding and design, and we are moving forward with resolve.

In uncertain times, it is our experience, mission and your support - that sustains us. Thank you for standing with us, and with the communities we serve.

We are honored to open the doors to 148 new affordable homes and 94 preserved homes for individuals, young adults, families and seniors.



CATALYST HOUSING. LYNN

24 units of affordable, supportive studio apartments for at-risk youth ages 18-24, including supportive services provided by The Haven Project.



ANCHOR POINT 2, BEVERLY

Phase 2, with 39 units of affordable 2- and 3- bedroom apartments for families with robust resident services and on-site playground and splashpad.



BEVERLY VILLAGE FOR LIVING & THE ARTS. BEVERLY

A joint venture with Beacon Communities for 85 affordable homes for seniors and 6 (market rate) live/work studios for artists.



AGAWAM VILLAGE. IPSWICH

Renewal in Partnership with the Ipswich Housing Authority providing 14 affordable homes for families; and 80 affordable homes for seniors 62+ years of age.
